# When does Spring begin ?

The technical bit ...

Astronomical seasons are governed by the position of Earth's orbit in relation to the Sun, equinoxes and solstices, so this year astronomical spring begins on **Sunday 20<sup>th</sup> March 2022.**

Meteorological seasons are based on the annual temperature cycle and meteorological state, as well as coinciding with the calendar, making a clear break between the seasons. So, by the meteorological calendar, spring will always start on 1<sup>st</sup> March.
