

OFF TO UGANDA

Many of you know that Larry and June went to Uganda a few years ago. Through them EBC has been giving excellent support to **Bronze Health Clinic** in Eastern Uganda.

You may not be aware that Steve and Janet also work in Uganda, in the capital, Kampala. They first went to Uganda with their children in 2006 on a family mission trip to celebrate their 25th wedding anniversary. Rather than the 'one-off' trip they were expecting, God has opened doors at a number of levels over the last 16 years. Their link Uganda CRANE—Children is at Risk Action Network. CRANE has over 100 member organisations, all Christian projects that work with vulnerable children. The network is well respected in the city and is involved in a variety of major areas, such as: girls' education, advocating for children with disabilities, raising the standards of safeguarding and child protection,

promoting fostering and adoption, helping churches become more childfriendly, and working within the judicial system to help the courts deal more sensitively with children involved in court cases.

It has been an exciting journey of development, and Steve and Janet are privileged to play a supporting role to the growing staff at CRANE. They generally make two trips a year and stay for about 10 days. Each trip different responsibilities. involves according to the network's needs at the time. They will be in Uganda July 13-25. Their schedule is still a 'work in progress', but one definite fixed point is a two day marriage conference (July 22-23) for influential leaders and their (politicians, business spouses top leaders. people from the police. education, the judiciary) led by Steve and Janet. Please pray that this event will help and encourage the over 100 couples who will attend in terms of their own marriages, but also as they influence wider society.
