

As well as praying, we can all keep alert to what may be happening around us.

8 signs of modern slavery are:

- Evidence of a workplace being used for accommodation.
- Workers distrustful of authorities.
- Workers look uneasy, unkempt or malnourished.
- · Signs of psychological trauma.
- Untreated injuries.
- Evidence of control over movement (being picked up and dropped off in groups)
- Signs of substance misuse.
