

# A note on the 'Churches supporting asylum-seekers and refugees in hotels' (CCOW webinar, 30 Jan.)

There are none in Eynsham, but there are hotels accommodating refugees in Oxford, Witney, Abingdon, Bicester and Banbury (lodged there by the government for lack of other accommodation).

It was heartening to hear how churches, among others, are supporting and helping the refugees in some of these hotels. There are many challenges, not least just being allowed in to the hotels, but also achievements and successes in offering immediate practical help (like shoes and clothing), helping refugees to cope with their long stays in the hotels, the long waits and slow process of their asylum applications, and arranging activities outside the hotels. includina volunteering (they are not allowed to be employed).

Asylum Welcome is working with refugees in the hotel in Oxford, and is giving advice and support to churches and others working elsewhere in Oxfordshire. I hope EBC will continue to support Asylum Welcome in this and its other work. EBC might also consider joining the nationwide network of 'Welcome Churches' welcomina their and refugees to churches communities.
