

Here's an easy no-cook cake recipe which you might like to get an adult to help you make - and they will probably help clean up afterwards!

#### MARS BAR CAKE



Ingredients: 3 Mars bars 150g butter 150g rice crispies 150g chocolate


#### Method:

In a pan, slowly melt the Mars bars and butter together - you can do this in a microwave too.

Remove from the heat and add the rice crispies, a little at a time, until they are completely covered with the mixture. Spread the mixture onto a baking sheet and put it in the fridge until hard.

Melt the chocolate and cover the mixture with it. Return it to the fridge for a further half an hour until the chocolate is set. Cut into pieces. Share and enjoy!
