

We, the management, staff and children of Baphumelele would like to thank you ALL for your generous monetary donations to Baphumelele children's home since inception for almost 21 years of ongoing support from our kindergarten, hence I want to use this moment to register my appreciation to all of you for your kindness and loyal support that you have shown all these years that has led towards expansion of this organization, through your support and your unconditional love, about nine programmes were born orphaned which serves children, patients, feeding the poorest of the poor etc. daily and to ensure Baphumelele managed to continue to deliver a service to those in our community who desperately needed support and help, without your efforts to raise funds yearly we would not have been able to continue to do this much needed work, and for even funding the

removal of a deadly Asbestos roofing to one of the houses, that was the best gift of life you have ever given to these vulnerable and orphaned children.

Your contribution has helped us to save young, innocent children, who have been orphaned and abandoned as little babies mainly due to the HIV/Aids pandemic which is rampant in our country. Most of these children are HIV positive themselves.
