During January and February our theme for reflection at EBC is 'Unity in Christ'. This will be explored in the Sunday preaching series, in the Thursday Bible Studies at church, and in an Online Study Group on Wednesdays at 8pm led by Nick Wood for about 40 minutes. Other small groups in the church are invited to share in the theme as appropriate for them.

As well as appropriate scripture passages, the theme will be explored with the help of Francis Chan's book, *'Until Unity'*. Chan is an American nondenominational pastor, of Hong Kong Chinese heritage, where he has also spent time in ministry.

The series will culminate in our worship

on Sunday 11th February, followed by a time of fellowship and conversation together over lunch.
