Empty shoeboxes are also welcomed.

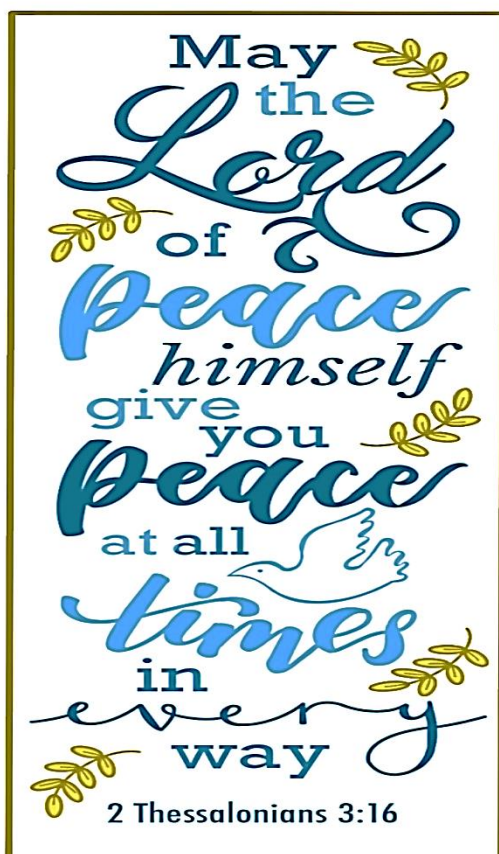
