At the Special Church Meeting last September we agreed to review the questions of finance, ministry and mission at the start of this year. At Zoltan's suggestion, we are holding a further Special Church Meeting on Sunday 25th February at 12 noon. This is Zoltan's monthly Sunday free of church responsibilities. The Worship Team have asked Richard Crippen to take our service, and the Deacons have asked Maureen Thompson to chair the meeting and facilitate our conversation.

Nick Wood will introduce the meeting and will speak to the current financial situation and its implications for paid ministry over the next year or two. This will lead into a wider conversation about our priorities for ministry and mission. The Deacons are proposing that we frame the discussion using these four questions:

- 1. What do we currently do well?
- 2. What could we do better?
- 3. What **should we do** that we are not currently doing?
- 4. What **might we stop doing** if it is no longer appropriate or effective?

We do hope that all members of the church, and all regular worshippers at EBC, will give these issues their careful and prayerful consideration, and if at all possible, attend the meeting in person or via Zoom.



Ash Wednesday - 14th February

The Fourth Gospel never once refers to the beloved disciple by name as John (...), who as the beloved disciple was and is one and the same person who reclined next to Jesus at the final supper, on Maundy Thursday evening, and it is from the perspective of his intimate relationship with Jesus that everything in the Fourth Gospel is recorded.

Question of the day: Am I close enough to Christ to become a reliable witness?

Thursday 15th February

"Many other signs truly Jesus did in the presence of his disciples, which are not written in this book" (John 20:30, NKJV).

The author of the Gospel explains to the reader the reasons for recording the many events in the Gospel as 'signs' (...) written 'so that you may come to believe that Jesus is the Messiah, the Son of God, and that through believing, you may have life in his name'.

Prayer of the day: "Lord, give eyes that recognise the signs of your love and I continue to believe in Jesus, so that my life will be renewed."

Friday 16th February

"In my Father's house there are many resting places and I go to prepare a place for you" (NKJV, John 14:2).

"In Greek language resting places is caravanserais – wayside inns, or staging posts, where travelers on long journeys could spend a night of rest before setting of again. It may be that we are still far from perfect fellowship with the Father. We have a long journey of many days before our pilgrimage is accomplished. But there are by God's mercy many resting places, many, many resting places along the way."

Question of the day: Do I recognise when on my spiritual journey I need to have a rest?
