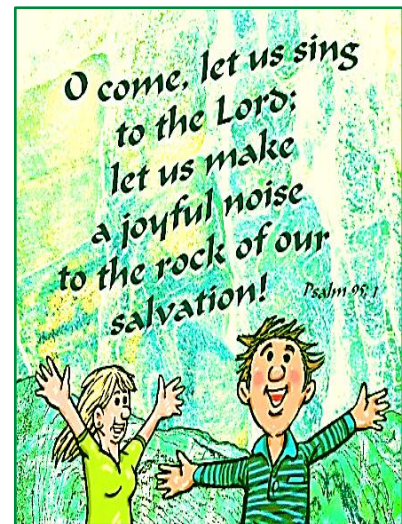

The following piece was originally shared by Denise (in 2016) and as we start our new Preaching Series on Christian Disciplines with **'Why Read the Bible?'** it seemed a good time to re-print it.

WHO IS JESUS?

Consider the themes in the books of the Bible.

In **GENESIS** He is the Creator God. In **EXODUS** He is the Redeemer. In **LEVITICUS** He is your sanctification. In **NUMBERS** He is your guide. In **DEUTERONOMY** He is your teacher. In **JOSHUA** He is the mighty conqueror. In **JUDGES** He gives victory over enemies. In **RUTH** He is your kinsman, your lover, your Redeemer. In **1 SAMUEL** He is the root of Jesse; in **2 SAMUEL** He is the Son of David. In **1 KINGS & 2 KINGS** He is King of Kings and Lord of Lords. In **1st & 2nd CHRONICLES** He is your intercessor and high priest. In **EZRA** He is your temple, your house of worship. In **NEHEMIAH** He is your mighty wall, protecting from your enemies. In **ESTHER** He stands in the gap to deliver you from your enemies. In **JOB** He is the arbitrator who not only understands your struggles, but has the power to do something about them. In **PSALMS** He is your song and your reason to sing. In **PROVERBS** He is your wisdom, helping you make sense of life and live it successfully. In **ECCLESIASTES** He is your purpose, delivering you from vanity. In the **SONG OF SOLOMON** He is your lover, your Rose of Sharon. In **ISAIAH** He is the mighty counsellor, the Prince of Peace, the Everlasting Father and more: in short, He is everything you need. 
