

He came to them with eyes of love, With nail scarred hands and pierced feet. He came, and all their joy o'erflowed, As they their risen Lord did greet.


He is alive! Rejoice! Be glad! Worship, wonder and adore. He comes to us to be our friend, And Saviour, Lord, for evermore.
