12.00 noon COMMUNION A weekly, short, reflective service at which all are welcome: held in the hall.

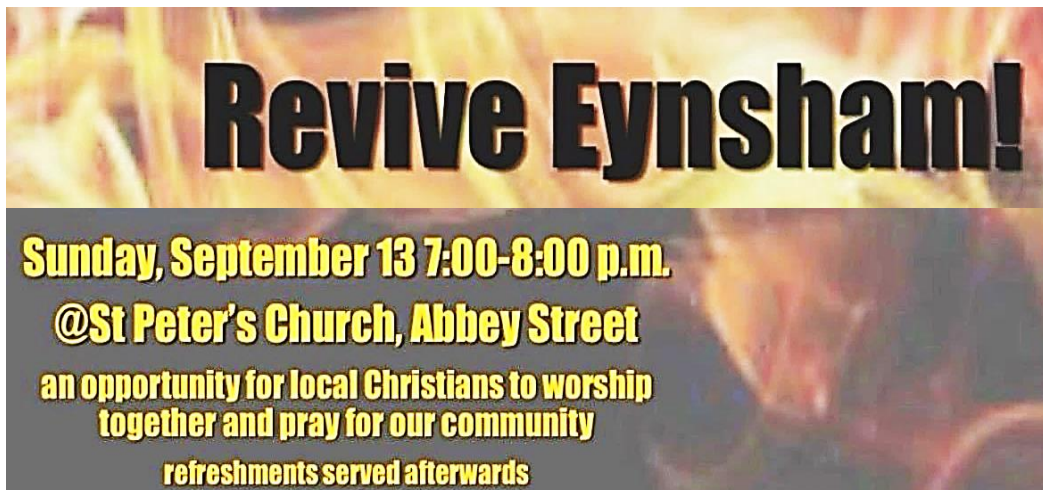

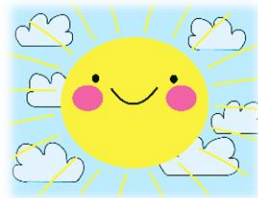
PLEASE PRAY FOR:

They will be back soon. **You may have to come in via the side door on Sunday! Please watch where you walk - there may be signs and barriers: parents please supervise children.**



IN THIS CURRENT VERY HOT WEATHER PLEASE REMEMBER ...

- Stay hydrated – drink plenty of water.
- Avoid any exercise between 11am and 3pm, when the sun is strongest.
- Close curtains in rooms that face the sun.
- Wear sunscreen and a hat when outside.
- Remember that even on very hot days, the water in lakes and the sea, even though hotter than usual, is still very cold. The RNLI warns entering it suddenly *“can lead to cold water shock, causing a sudden increase in breathing and heart rate, which may trigger panic.”*

If you find yourself in trouble in cold water, remember to *Float to Live*.

1. Tilt your head back, so that your ears are submerged
2. Relax and control your breathing
3. You may need to gently use your hands to help you stay afloat
4. It's OK if your legs sink - everyone floats differently.

If you are at the seaside, where possible choose a lifeguarded beach, and only swim between the red and yellow flags.
